

### Bus services

Service 12 runs approximately every two hours from **Stamford to Uppingham** via Barrowden Monday to Friday only. Buses depart from the village green.

Service R47 to **Peterborough** is once a day on Monday to Friday only. It leaves Barrowden 07:31, arrives Peterborough bus station 08.10 and departs Peterborough bus station 16:05, arrives Barrowden 16.40

## Community Shop

Our Community Shop serves the people of Barrowden and surrounding villages with a good range of general provisions, local bread, fruit and vegetables, dairy products and meats.

You will always find a warm welcome at the shop where David and our volunteer team are on hand to help meet your needs. If you choose, you can place a regular standing order for your newspapers and magazines and for fresh Kings Cliffe bread.

The shop has become a meeting place for many villagers, where they can enjoy delicious fresh ground coffee and home-made cakes in our coffee shop, or a light lunch (Monday to Friday) We also offer a postal service, with a daily collection from the post box in the shop, and a weekly dry cleaning service. Free wi-fi is available and the shop has disabled access.

Our shop is owned by the village to serve the village, and is supported by a dedicated team of volunteers, who not only serve in the shop but also, for the more "green-fingered", to help keep our gardens looking their best. We are always pleased to welcome new volunteers into the team, it's a great way to get to know other villagers, and indeed to make new friends.



## Libraries

A mobile library comes regularly to Barrowden. It carries a good selection of regular and large print books and dvds. An ordering service is available.

The mobile library visits fortnightly on Wednesdays: 11.50 to 12.10 at 6 Seaton Road; 12.10 to 12.30 outside the Exeter Arms, Main Street; 12.35 to 12.50 in Mill Lane.

## Pub

The Exeter Arms, Main Street is a free of tie pub serving freshly prepared food, a selection of real ales, draught lagers and cider, wines and soft drinks. It is open from 6pm on Tuesday until 6pm on Sunday and offers pub/bistro/restaurant style food using locally sourced, seasonal produce wherever possible. The pub can also cater for functions, for example birthday parties, weddings and christenings. It has a large beer garden suitable for families and children and for eating outside in warm weather. ## Recreation Ground

The recreation ground has a children's play area, football area with goal posts and is home to Barrowden and Wakerley

### **Refuse Collection**

There is an alternate weekly bin collection. The black bin (household waste) is collected one week and the grey bin (recycling) is collected the week after. The green bin for garden waste is collected at the same time as the grey bin. 


### **Shopping in nearby towns**

Stamford offers a range of supermarkets, with Waitrose being nearest to Barrowden (8 miles). There is a Co-op at Uppingham. There is also a Waitrose & a Co-op at Oundle (13 miles). Oakham has three large supermarkets, Tesco, the Co-op and Aldi.

Market days are Friday in Uppingham, Friday in Stamford, Wednesday and Saturday in Oakham and Thursday in Oundle. There are regular farmers' markets in the area – Oakham on the third Saturday of each month, in Gaol Street; Stamford every second Friday; Oundle every second Saturday.

Nelson's butchers in Uppingham and Stamford also deliver to the village on Fridays



**St. Peter's Church,**  
**Barrowden**

St. Peter's is the 12<sup>th</sup> century local parish church in Barrowden. It is the largest of the churches in the five parishes that make up the Welland Foss Benefice, the others being South Luffenham, Morcott, Tixover and Duddington. The parish of Barrowden includes Wakerley, a redundant church but which has a few services a year.

Here at Barrowden we have a service every Sunday over the four weeks of a month, with the occasional fifth Sunday being a Benefice service which is shared around all the parishes.

Third Sunday in month (non-Eucharist)	11.00 a.m. Morning Praise
