I do not wish to speak, but would like my comments noted in relation to a residents proposal to allow the village green grass to grow, encouraging bio diversity.

I believe the village green should continue to be cut.

We live in an area surrounded by unused green space more than adequately supporting bio diversity. The green is used for village events such as the fete and has hosted vintage car rallies etc and this year would have been a focus for VE day commemorations.

Allowing the green to become overgrown would prevent social use, encourage weed growth and make it more difficult to return to its pristine condition at the centre of the village.
