I'm writing in response to your article in the April issue of the Parish magazine, in which you ask for comments from residents regarding the proposed Thomas Cook site.

My view is that we need less not more signs in Barrowden. Barrowden is a country village, not a museum and these heritage signs are not conducive to my personal idea of what a village should be. As a long term resident of Barrowden I would see the sign as a symptom of a wider malaise - the idea that everything should be signed, or kerbed, or paved or illuminated or nature in some way 'controlled'. I feel that sort of thing belongs in a city, not our beautiful village.
