

**Report Wakerley Quarry Local Liaison Group Meeting  
9th May 2017, Laxton Village Hall**

Sheila Saunders represented Barrowden Parish Council with seven other persons on May 7th.

John Gough , Mick George Limited chaired the meeting.

No comments on previous meeting minutes.

**Matters arising** site operating times confirmed 0700 to 1800 hours Monday to Friday and 0700 to 1300 hours Saturdays.

**Landowner & Operator's update/Future plans& discussion.**

1. A43 was re-opened. Fineshade Road would re-open at the end of the week. There had been no major issues in respect of road works

2. Permission had been granted for the dust suppression ponds to the north of the site. Archaeologists have found a number of ancient bodies which will delay the work until further exploration has been undertaken.

It was hoped to continue excavation within a few weeks. Stone removed would be used for road construction.

3. Reptile relocation being taken over a 60 day period.

4. Final remedial work necessary to complete the new footpath location. Then the footpath officer will confirm the route of the new footpath.

**Northants County Council Update .** Positive approval of information on any applications or works to the liaison group.

Pleased to know of reptile relocation.

Northants archaeologist had an appointment to visit the suppression pond site with MGL consultant.

**Environment Agency update** No EA officer present

**Local community questions** It was stated that earth moving would not start until after the completion of the ponds . This was expected to be late summer, early autumn.

The archaeological report will be circulated to the group once completed.

The next meeting will,be confirmed for sometime in the autumn when the quarrying work has commenced.
